# PROFILES



**Mazlan Othman** obtained a Ph.D. in Astrophysics from the University of Otago, New Zealand. Currently, she is the Director of the International Science Council (ISC) Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific (ROAP). Mazlan's previous appointments include Director-General of Malaysian Space Agency, Director of United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs and Deputy Director-General of the United Nations Office at Vienna. She is also a Senior Fellow of the Academy of Sciences, Malaysia.

**Jasmin Irisha** helps mobilise young people on climate action. She is the Climate and Environment Consultant at UNICEF Malaysia, where her work focuses on addressing climate change and environmental degradation impacts on children and advancing children's rights to a healthy environment. Previously, she was the former Manager of the Malaysian Youth Delegation to the UNFCCC COP and have held research positions at the Earth Institute and Jeffrey Sachs Center on Sustainable Development. Jasmin holds a Masters in Climate and Society from Columbia University, and BSc. (Hons) Environmental Science from University of Nottingham, Malaysia.



**Daniel Mahadzir** is a clinical nutritionist and social entrepreneur working on planetary health and food system. He is the Director for Research and Development at Adeante Corporation, a Malaysian investment holding company for green technology. His previous affiliations include Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences (JCSMH) and United Nations University International Institute for Global Health (UNU-IIGH). Dr. Daniel is also the Curator for World Economic Forum Global Shapers Kuala Lumpur, co-leader of U-Inspire Alliance, a Climate Reality Leader and Governance Chair for Youth UNESCO Climate Action Network, and a proud alumnus of RMIT and Monash University, Australia

**Shubhangi Rana** is a civil engineer by profession and social entrepreneur by passion. She works as the Engineering Officer at CDM Smith, for their Nepal Reconstruction Engineering Services program funded by USAID. She is the co-founder of Pad2Go (est. October 2018), a social enterprise that promotes menstrual health management in Nepal in a holistic manner. She has been listed in the Forbes 30 under 30 list of 2020, as one of the social entrepreneurs from Asia. She is also a member of the Global Shapers Kathmandu Hub.
